# **CHAPTER 343 - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:**

In accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rule Section 11-200-8(a)(1)(4) the subject request is exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment pursuant to Exemption Class No. 4, that exempts activities, which involve "Minor alteration in the conditions of land, water, or vegetation." Staff consulted the Office of Conservation and Coastal Lands and was advised that they had no objection to the proposed activities due to the temporary and minimally intrusive nature of the activities.

## REMARKS:

Pursuant to the authority delegated by the Board on September 28, 2001 (D-4), right-of-entry permits were issued for these types of activities (group gatherings, dinner function) in the past. The applicant is the owner of the inland property at TMK: (2) 3-9-009:008. She is hosting a dinner event at her residence and has requested to utilize a portion of the State beach reserve which abuts her private lawn for additional seating purposes.

After discussion about different types of commercial activities and any associated requirements, staff brings the request to the Board for disposition. The form of disposition should be in form of a Right-of-Entry permit.

Applicant has not had a lease, permit, easement or other disposition of State lands terminated within the past five years due to non-compliance with such terms and conditions.

No comments were solicited from government or community agencies.

Ms. Schulenburg is requesting a right-of-entry permit for this one day event, to utilize a portion of the Waiohuli-Keokea Beach Reserve. There will be placement of four seating and two food service tables on the subject area. The event is scheduled for April 6, 2013 between the hours of 3:00pm to 7:00 pm.

There are no other pertinent issues or concerns. Staff has no objections to this request.

## **RECOMMENDATION:** That the Board:

- 1. Authorize the issuance of a right-of-entry permit to Charlene Schulenburg (Event Manager) for the Non-Profit benefit dinner event, covering the subject area for seating and dinning purposes under the terms and conditions cited above, which are by this reference incorporated herein and further subject to the following:
  - a. The standard terms and conditions of the most current right-of-entry permit form, as may be amended from time to time;
  - b. The Board declare this Right-of-Entry exempt under Chapter 343 of the Hawaii Revised Statues;
  - Review and approval by the Board of Land & Natural Resources; and
  - d. Such other terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Chairperson to best serve the interests of the State.




