In accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rule Section 11-200-8(a)(1) and (4) and the Exemption List for the Department of Land and Natural Resources approved by the Environmental Council and dated December 4, 1991, the subject request is exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment pursuant to Exemption Class No. 1, that states "Operations, repairs or maintenance of existing structures, facilities, equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion or change of use beyond that previously existing" and Class No. 4, that states "Minor alteration in the conditions of land, water, or vegetation.", as explained in Exhibit 2.

REMARKS:

Waikiki Roughwater Swim Committee, Inc. (WRSC) is requesting permission to use the Duke Kahanamoku Beach for the finish of the 44th Annual Waikiki Roughwater Swim race event. The event is scheduled for Monday, September 2, 2013, from 5:30 a.m. to 6 p.m., including the set-up and tear-down times on the beach. Included within Exhibit 3, is a map furnished by the applicant describing the requested beach areas for use by the swim race event. A race finish line fronting the beach area of the Hilton Hawaiian Village Hotel will consist of 1,100 square feet, including a timing and announcer's table. WRSC requests the use of 200 additional square feet of beach area situated adjacent to the finish line for the set up of two tents, serving medical doctor and first aid purposes. For T-shirt distribution purposes, the applicant requests the use of another 200 square feet of beach area for the placement of a tent. Further, an additional 200 square feet of tented area is being requested for: "Clothes Pick-up". The proposed right-of-entry permit would include the use of a total of 1,700 square feet of beach area.

The proposed activity is of a similar type and scope of beach activities that periodically occurred and continues to occur on this and other beach areas across the State. Such activities have resulted in no known significant impacts, whether immediate or cumulative, to the natural, environmental and/or cultural resources in the area. As such, staff believes that the proposed event would involve negligible or no expansion or change in use of the subject area beyond that previously existing.

Applicant has not had a lease, permit, easement or other disposition of State lands terminated within the past five years due to non-compliance with such terms and conditions.

Staff has no objections to the subject request.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board

- 1. Declare that, after considering the potential effects of the proposed disposition as provided by Chapter 343, HRS, and Chapter 11-200, HAR, this project will probably have minimal or no significant effect on the environment and is therefore exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment.
- 2. Authorize the issuance of a right-of-entry permit to Waikiki Roughwater Swim Committee, Inc. for the purpose of covering the subject area for the swim race event under the terms and conditions cited above, which are by this reference incorporated herein and further subject to the following:
 - a. The standard terms and conditions of the most current right-of-entry permit form, as may be amended from time to time; and
 - b. Such other terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Chairperson to best serve the interests of the State.


