Approval to Enter Supplemental Contract for Grant-in-Aid Agreement with The Oceanic Institute for Feed Mill Laboratory, Hawaii

The Engineering Division desires to execute a supplemental contract to Contract No. 47455, Agreement for Grants, Subsidies and Purchase of Service with The Oceanic Institute (OI) for the development of a feed mill laboratory at the Panaewa Agricultural Park, Hawaii.

BACKGROUND

On September 8, 2000, the Board of Land and Natural Resources gave approval to enter a grant-in-aid agreement with The Oceanic Institute for the development of a feed mill laboratory utilizing funds appropriated by Act 91, SLH 1999, Item A-10. The original grant agreement was executed on November 9, 2000. Due to various delays, including project redesign and budget shortfalls, OI requested and was granted four no-cost time extensions. The current expiration date is December 31, 2013.

OI now requests a no-cost time extension to December 31, 2015 to complete this project (Attachment 1). OI has secured additional funding and has contracted the design and preparation of an environmental assessment for this work.

RECOMMENDATION

- 1. That the Board of Land and Natural Resources authorize the Chairperson to enter a supplemental contract to Contract No. 47455 for a no-cost time extension to December 31, 2015 and sign the necessary documents pertaining to the project, subject approval as to form by the Department of the Attorney General.
- 2. That the Board authorize the Chairperson, subject to review and approval by the Department of the Attorney General, to enter into additional supplemental contracts to address unforeseen project-related conditions and sign the necessary documents to implement the additional work.

Re: Contract Number 47455, Grant-in-Aid for Feed Mill Laboratory, Hawaii

The Oceanic Institute (OI) requests a no-cost time extension through December 31, 2015, to complete the work under contract number 47455. During the previous three years, although there was no physical progress, many behind the scenes hurdles have been overcome. The capital budget for the project has been increased by over one million dollars. OI has accomplished this by cancelling two of its capital projects and consolidating its U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) funding and securing an additional \$450,000 in capital funding from the State Department of Agriculture (DOA).

USDA approved the design fees negotiated with Parsons Brinckerhoff (PB) in March 2013. PB began design work and the Environmental Assessment (EA) in April 2013. Work is progressing on the design and EA.

Ol is also in on-going discussions with Ulupono Initiative to improve production efficiencies of the feed mill. Ulupono's interest in the feed mill stems from their broader interests in island sustainability and their desire to help develop local solutions to reduce the high cost of terrestrial and aquatic feed. Ol's feed mill will provide a platform to test novel feed formulations on a commercial scale and this is of significant value to Ulupono. Currently, Ol and Ulupono are exploring funding opportunities to support enhanced capabilities for the feed mill.
