AMENDMENT NO. 3 TO CONCESSION AGREEMENT NO. DOT-A-11-0006 RESTAURANT AND LOUNCE CONCESSION, ADDITIONAL SPACE HOST INTERNATIONAL, INC. LIHUE AIRPORT

TAX MAP KEY: (4) 3-5-01: 8 (PORTION)

PURPOSE:

To amend the existing Concession Agreement at Lihue Airport to allow for additional floor space to facilitate the food and beverage operations. Under Article III. (Premises) of the Lease, the specific area assigned or provided for the concession activity may be changed at the discretion of the Director of Transportation.

LEASE COMMENCEMENT DATE:

October 1, 2011 through September 30, 2021.

ADDITIONAL PREMISES:

Building 306, Space No.219D, containing an area of approximately 606 square feet as shown on the attached Exhibit H, dated February 2014.

CONCESSION FEE:

No additional square footage floor rent will be charged. All gross receipts generated from the additional space will be included with the gross receipts of the concession. The concession pays the greater of minimum annual guaranteed fee or a percentage fee of gross receipts as provided in Article VI. (Concession Fee).

IMPROVEMENTS:

Applicant at its own cost and expense shall be responsible for any renovation, upgrade, remodeling, and improvement to the additional space.

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

Pursuant to Section 11-200-8 (a), Environmental Impact Statement Rules of the Department of Health, State of Hawaii, this disposition is exempt from requirements regarding preparation of an environmental assessment, negative declaration, or environmental impact statement as required by Chapter 343, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, relating to Environmental Impact Statements because the proposed action falls within Exemption Class #3, Comprehensive Exemption List for the State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation Amended November 15, 2000, as approved by the Environmental Quality Council. Exemption Class #3 covers the construction and location of single, new, small facilities or structures and the alteration and modification of same and installation of new, small equipment and facilities and the alteration and modification of same including, but not limited to: (d) Water, sewage, electrical, gas, telephone and other essential public utility services extensions to serve such structures or facilities and (e) Accessory or appurtenant structures.

REMARKS:

The Department of Transportation and Host International, Inc. entered into that certain Concession Agreement (DOT-A-11-0006), effective October 1, 2011, for the Restaurant and Lounge Concession at the Lihue Airport. The additional space will allow Host International, Inc. to better serve the traveling public.

The Board authorize the Department of Transportation to: (1) amend Article III. (Premises) of the subject Agreement as herein outlined, which are by reference incorporated herein; 2) such other terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Director of Transportation to best serve the interests of the State; and 3) review and approval by the Department of the Attorney General.
