## <u>APPLICANT:</u>

Mokulele Flight Service, Inc. doing business as Mokulele Airlines, a domestic profit corporation registered to do business in the State of Hawaii, whose mailing address is 73-350 U'u Street, Kailua-Kona, Hawaii 96740.

## **LOCATION:**

Portion of Kalaeloa Airport, Kapolei, Island of Oahu, State of Hawaii, identified by Tax Map Key: 1st Division, 9-1-13: Portion of 32

#### AREA:

Building/Space No.104-128, containing an area of approximately 103 square feet; Space No. 104-129, containing an area of approximately 21 square feet; and Space No. 001-123, containing an area of approximately 400 square feet, as shown and delineated on the attached map labeled Exhibit A.

### **CURRENT USE STATUS:**

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 3861, setting aside Kalaeloa Airport under the control and management of the Department of Transportation, Airports Division, State of Hawaii for Airport Purposes.

## **CHARACTER OF USE:**

Mokulele will occupy a portion of Building 104 for passenger check-in counter and storage, and land area, Space No. 001-123 for equipment storage for airline operations.

#### **REMARKS**:

In accordance with Section 171-55, HRS, relating to <u>Permits</u>, the Department of Transportation proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to Mokulele Flight Service, Inc., to occupy a portion of Building 104 to use as passenger check-in counter and storage, and a portion of land, Space No. 001-123 to be used for equipment storage in support of passenger airline operation at Kalaeloa Airport.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Board authorize the Department of Transportation to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to Mokulele Flight Service, Inc. subject to: (1) terms and conditions herein outlined, which are by reference incorporated herein; (2) such other terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Director of Transportation to best serve the interests of the State; and (3) review and approval by the Department of the Attorney General.
