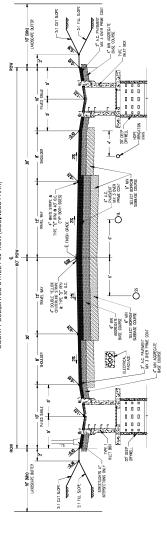




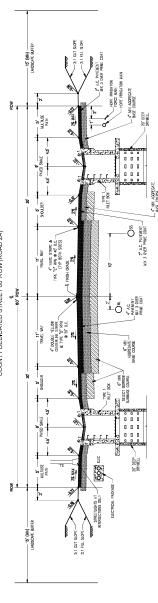




Conceptual Road Section For Street Type 4 COUNTY BEDICATED STREET 60 ROW (BUSINESS PARK)

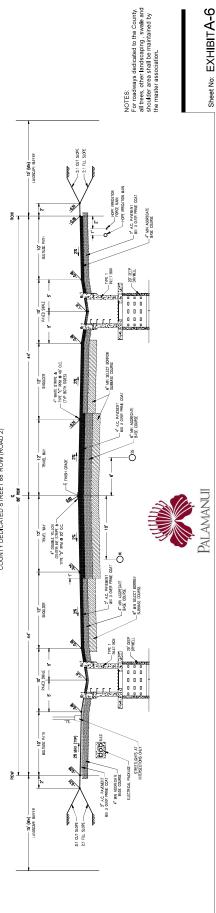


Conceptual Road Section For Street Type 2 COUNTY DEDICATED STREET 60 ROW (ROAD 24)

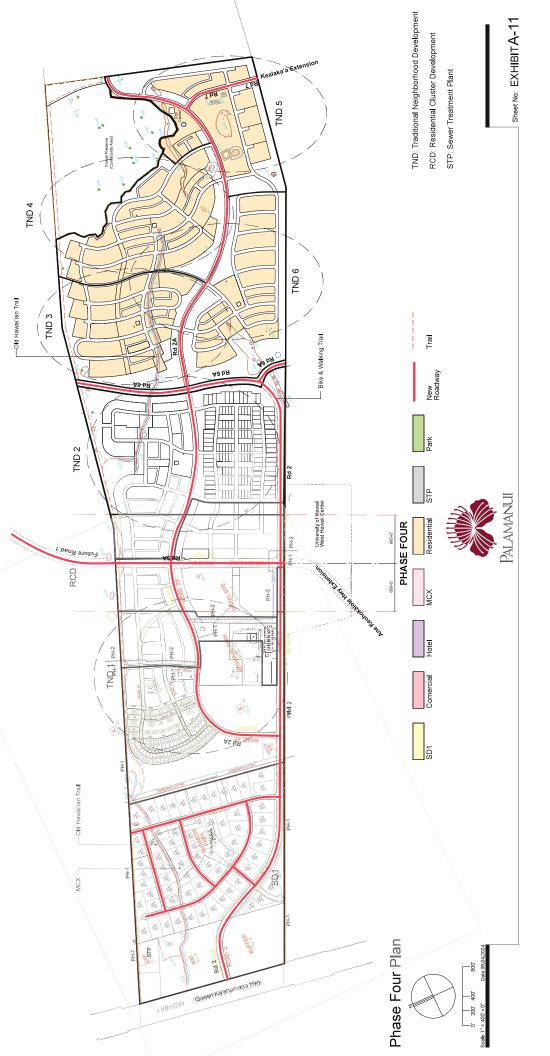
