Dear Mr. Orodenker:

I am writing this letter to express my great concern and opposition to the expansion of Sanford's quarry in Leilani. I am a resident of Kamaili Rd. in Kaueleau, which closely borders the proposed expansion. The community (of humans, plants and animals) in this area has undergone tremendous stress over the last year. We are only starting to recover. The environmental impact to this area from the 2018 LERZ eruption is tremendous. We endured high levels of SO₂ gases during the eruption which killed many plants and displaced wildlife and humans. We also have increased traffic, noise and tourists both on the ground and in the air since then. If the the quarry expansion is allowed, this area will face further hardships including more noise and traffic due to heavy machinery, along with less habitat for plants and animals, which have already suffered greatly. The area of requested quarry expansion is conservation land and should remain that way! I request that areas in this vicinity, untouched by lava, remain untouched by humans as well, for the sake of the environment and residents.
