Jurisdiction Notice Under Protest

Dwight J. Vicente Representing the Sovereignty of the Hawaiian Kingdom under the 1840 Constitution and the 1848 Mahele (Kanaka Land Trust), within its Longitude and Latitude geographical jurisdiction. 1-17-1893 Queen Liliuokalani's Protest against Nefarious U.S. Minister Stevens, this has yet to make its way to the U.S. Supreme Court. Do this Jurisdiction Notice Under Protest.

History; The 1840 Constitution this Kingdom became a civilized government in the family of Nations. In the 1848 Mahele, the Lands became Crown and Government Lands within its geographical jurisdiction. The Lands were to be leased under Common Law Contract, subject to the Kanaka on the Land to raise revenue to support this Kingdom.

In 1820 President Monroe acting under the Northwest Ordinance July 1787 without any amendment started the illegal colonization of this Kingdom. This violated the limits of the U.S. Constitution and its history. In 1826 did a Fake Treaty. 1875 tree U.S. Citizens Fish, Allen and Carter did a Reciprocity Proclamation to apply the Northwest Ordinance of July 1787 to this Kingdom without amendment for colonization, (Mabury v. Madison), (Downs v. Bidwell), ((Sai v. Obama), (Sai v. Trump), (New York Pistol and Rifle Association v. Bruan).

1890 King Kalakaua leased over 2.2 million acres of Crown and Government Lands for 30 years, 1890 to 1920. January 1893 Queen Liliuokalani was illegally deposed by illegal aliens, because she signed the lottery into Law, Blounts 1893 Report. In 1898 the illegitimate/fraudulent Banana Republic of Hawaii Ceded 1.750 acres of Crown and Government Lands to the U.S. by a Joint Resolution to U.S. Congress under the Northwest Ordinance. This was to become the illegitimate Territory of Hawaii, 1920 Hawaiian Homes. 1959 the illegitimate equal footing State Hawaii, (State v. Jim 2004). Today the over 2.2 million acres of Crown and Government lease Lands are falsely claimed to be owned by illegal aliens. The State of Hawaii Supreme Court Ruled in (state v. Jim 2004) to be limited to the Ceded Lands. So we have the issues of the Crown and Government Lease Lands and Crown and Government Ceded Lands, all together over 4.2 million acres of Lands in this Kingdom.

I believe Docket No.: A26-812 lacks jurisdiction for this is a part of the 2.2 million acres of the Hawaiian Kingdom's Lease Lands.
