These Lands appear to be part of the 2.2 million acres of Crown and Government Lands leased out by King Kalakaua for 30 years, from 1890 to 1920. The other Crown and Government Lands, 1.750 million acres, were illegally ceded to the U S Congress in 1898 by the 1875 Reciprocity Proclamation/Northwest Ordinance July 1787/1884 illegitimate Banana Republic of Hawaii. The History-Continental Congress Revolutionary War 1776/Northwest Ordinance of July 1787 is of Limited geographical Jurisdiction, to the Ohio River Valley Indian Reserve, No amendment.

The State Land Use Commission created in 1955 to usurp jurisdiction over these Lease Lands under the 1959 U S Congress Admission Act, this illegal Commission is of Limited jurisdiction, lacks jurisdiction to these Agricultural Lease Lands, these are Not the so Called Ceded Lands in, (State v. Jim 2004). This Case Limited the State of Hawaii and the Counties Jurisdiction to the Ceded Lands. You have a duty to enforce the Rule of Law.
