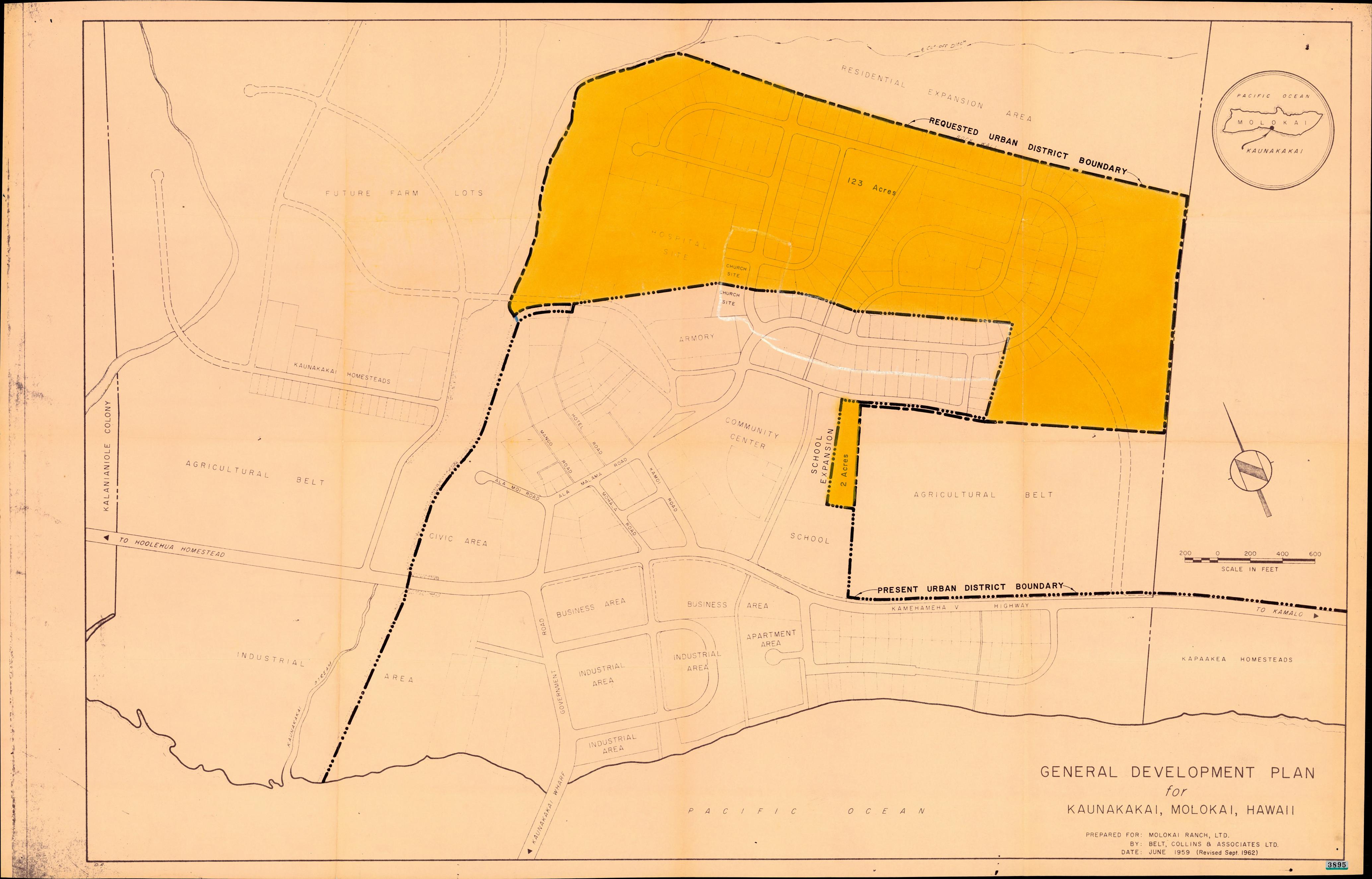

Temporary District Classification: AGRICULTURAL

PETITION OF COOKE TRUST CO., LTD., for Change of Temporary District Boundary to reclassify certain property adjacent to Kaunakakai from an Agricultural district to an Urban district classification described as TMK 5-3-03: Por. 1.

The petition is agent for the Molokai Ranch Company, Ltd., owners of the subject property, which is in two portions: (1) a tract of some 123 acres located immediately mauka of the town of Kaunakakai, including a portion of the new hospital site, and extending to an existing rock wall some 1200 feet mauka of the existing urban line; and (2) a parcel of approximately 2 acres mauka of the existing school, and behind the community center.

Kaunakakai is presently a very compact town, and the temporary Urban boundary was drawn quite close in, severely restricting the possibility of any significant expansion. Several plans (A Development Plan for the Lands of Molokai Ranch, Ltd., prepared by Belt, Collins & Associates; the General Plan for the State of Hawaii; the Molokai Land Use and Master Plan, prepared by Community Planning, Inc., for the Maui County Planning and Traffic Commission) are in complete agreement that the subject area is the most suitable area for any expansion of Kaunakakai. The land itself is poorly-suited to intensive cultivation, according to the Land Study Bureau, but is entirely suitable for urban development.
