

### STAFF REPORT

A(T) 62-28

Temporary District Classification: AGRICULTURAL

PETITION OF MURRAY YOULIN, for change of Temporary District Boundary from an Agricultural to an Urban district classification on land in Haiku, Maui, described as Second Division, TMK 2-7-03: 14.

The petitioner states that he is the husband and agent for the owner, Virginia S. Youlin.

The property situated some 800 feet, more or less, from the present temporary boundary of Haiku Village, has two residences on it. It could, along with existing development across the road from it, easily have been considered existing urban when the temporary district lines were adopted; but no protest was received until after the lines became official.

The staff agrees with the recommendation of the Maui County Planning and Traffic Commission, that this area is already reasonably urban in character. Accordingly, staff recommended to the Land Use Commission that the final Urban district line proposed by HB&A be extended to include the Youlin property, as well as the vacant flat area at the same elevation between the subject property and Haiku, in the proposed area for final Urban classification. Since this was not done, staff believes that the Commission: should make an inspection of the site.





Dear Mr. Youlin:

We have just received Opinion No. 62-38, dated July 31, 1962, from the Office of the State of Hawali Department of the Attorney General. The opinion mays: "Therefore, we conclude that the interim regulation pertaining to single family dwelling waits is invalid and unenforcible." In other words, in those areas somed as agriculture by the State Land Use Commission, single family dwelling units are not permissible. Accordingly, any subdivision primarily for single family dwelling purposes can not be approved.

The County of Mani has defined the standard for agricultural lets as one (1) acre for the Island of Mani. This is according to Ordinance No. 267 known as the Interim Zoning Ordinance. We find that your subdivision creates a lot approximately three-quarter

We regret the delay to act upon your request, however, it was necessary because Act 187, the Greenbelt Law, had to be clarified. According to that law, the only way your subdivision can be approved is by the change of montag from agriculture to urban, or by the greating of a special permit by the Land Use Commission.
