
Dear Mr. Orodener:

Pursuant to Section 15-15-42, Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR"), on behalf of the Office of Planning ("OP"), I respectfully request an extension for OP to file its response to Petitioner's Motion for Order Amending the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Decision and Order Filed May 8, 1989, filed with the Land Use Commission ("LUC") on November 6, 2019 ("Motion"), for Docket No. A88-627. The Motion was filed on November 6, 2019, and a response is normally due seven days after being served. *See* Section 15-15-70(e), HAR. I respectfully request that the deadline to respond to Petitioner's Motion be extended for sixty (60) days to January 13, 2020.
