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OFFICE OF PLANNING'S RESPONSE IN OPPOSITION TO DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING, COUNTY OF MAUI'S MOTION TO EXCLUDE FURTHER PUBLIC <u>TESTIMONY</u>

The OFFICE OF PLANNING, STATE OF HAWAI'I ("OP"), opposes the County of Maui Department of Planning's Motion to exclude further public testimony. The County of Maui Department of Planning's Motion indicates that the Land Use Commission has heard extensive public testimony on August 24, 2012, "in which a broad spectrum of viewpoints were expressed, both in favor of, and against, the proposed project." However, we note that at the August 24, 2012 public hearing, Vice Chair Heller specifically restricted testimony to the "matter of whether or not to grant the present Motion for Hearing on an Order to Show Cause..." (Tr. 8/24/12 at 11:14-17). Vice Chair Heller further explained that, "If this motion is granted, a full evidentiary hearing will be scheduled. And there will be an opportunity at that time, including a public opportunity, to present testimony regarding the Order to Show Cause."

(Tr. 8/24/12 at 12:2-6)

Furthermore, in accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rules, §15-15-58 (b):

"Together with other witnesses that the commission may desire to hear at the hearing, the commission shall also allow a representative of a citizen or community group to testify, who indicates a desire to express the views of those citizen or community group concerning the proposed boundary change."

The Commission routinely allows public testimony as a general practice at all public

hearings, and to do otherwise would be contrary to the public's expectation to express their

viewpoints on Land Use Commission matters.
