ORDER RECOGNIZING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAI'I AS THE SUCCESSOR-IN-INTEREST TO PETITIONER HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION OF HAWAI'I, STATE OF HAWAI'I, AND ASSIGNING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAI'I'S PROPERTY WITH A NEW DOCKET NUMBER

On March 9, 2007, the University of Hawai'i ("UH") filed a Motion To Amend Findings Of Fact, Conclusions Of Law, And Decision And Order Dated September 8, 1999 ("Motion"), pursuant to sections 15-15-70 and 15-15-94, Hawai'i Administrative Rules ("HAR"). In the Motion, the UH requested, among other things, that the Land Use Commission ("Commission") (i) recognize the UH as the successor-in-interest to Petitioner Housing and Community Development Corporation of Hawai'i, State of Hawai'i ("HCDCH"), in the above-entitled docket for the UH's 500.327-acre parcel (Land Court Lot 10077), identified as Tax Map Key: 9-1-16: 120, 127, and 129 ("Property"), in the Petition Area; (ii) recognize the Property as separate from

the remaining approximately 800 acres of land comprising the Petition Area; and (iii) if appropriate, redesignate this docket with a new docket number for the Property. A Memorandum In Support ("Memorandum") was attached to the Motion.

In the Memorandum, the UH stated, among other things, that as a result of the UH's acquisition of the Property for the development of the UH West O`ahu campus and community, the HCDCH is no longer directly involved in the development of the Property.

The Commission considered the matter at its meeting on May 17, 2007, in Honolulu, Hawai`i.¹ J. Douglas Ing, Esq.; Emi L.M. Kaimuloa, Esq.; and Gene I. Awakuni appeared on behalf of the UH. Bryan C. Yee, Esq.; Abe Mitsuda; and Scott Derrickson appeared on behalf of the State Office of Planning ("OP"). Lori Sunakoda, Esq., and Matt Higashida appeared on behalf of the City and County of Honolulu Department of Planning and Permitting ("DPP"). Yvonne Y. Izu, Esq., appeared on behalf of Intervenor Haseko (Ewa), Inc. ("Haseko")

At the meeting, a motion was made and seconded to (i) recognize the UH as the successor-in-interest to Petitioner HCDCH with respect solely to the Property; and (ii) treat the Property separately from the remaining approximately 800 acres of



## **ORDER**

This Commission, having duly considered this matter, the oral and written arguments presented by OP, the DPP, and Haseko, and a motion having been made at a meeting conducted on May 17, 2007, in Honolulu, Hawai`i, and the motion having received the affirmative votes required by section 15-15-13, HAR, and there being good cause for the motion,

HEREBY ORDERS that the UH shall be recognized as the successor-ininterest to Petitioner HCDCH with respect solely to the Property, and that the Property
shall be treated separately from the remaining approximately 800 acres of land
comprising the Petition Area in this docket and shall be assigned the Docket Number
A99-728(a). HCDCH shall continue to be the Petitioner of record for the remaining
approximately 800 acres of land comprising the Petition Area in Docket Number A99728.
