

STAFF REPORT

SP(T) 62-23

APPLICATION OF WILLIAM AND AMY SARMENTO, for Special Permit to subdivide a 1.847-acre parcel into two parcels, one of which will measure 6012 sq. ft., and will contain an existing single-family residence; at Lawai, in the Koloa District, County of Kauai described as TMK 2-5-04: 13.

The petitioners' interest in the property had not been ascertained at the time of writing the staff report. The tax map states that the owner of TMK 2-5-04: 13 is Dan Foster. William C. and Amy Sarmento owns a small lot, with residence on it, apparently also originally subdivided from the subject property; as was another lot and house next door to it, now in the name of Harry C. and Dorothy Sarmento. The property is a wedge-shaped parcel (with the aforementioned Sarmento pieces carved from it and having highway frontage) in the angle formed by Kaumualii Highway and Wawae Road. The Parcel, and Wawae Road, angle steeply downward from the Highway. The home mentioned in the application is at the narrow west end of the parcel. Adjacent to the property lie the cannery grounds of the Kauai Pineapple Company, the principal portion of which (but not reaching the subject property) is in the Lawai Temporary Urban District. The urban line along Koloa Road approaches to within 400 feet of the subject property.

Staff believes that HB&A intends to recommend that the entire property covered in this application be located within the Urban district when the final boundaries are set; this recommendation will likely be available at the close of the 15-day waiting period. If such be the case, staff will recommend that the permit be granted as requested by the applicant.
