Dr. Shelley M. Mark, who is the director of this department and an ex-officio member of the Land Use Commission, has authorized me to write you concerning the status of your application to the Commission for a special permit.

You are advised that the term of the last Commission expired on May 3, 1963 and that no action on your application was taken prior to that date. On June 17, 1963 Governor Burns signed into law Act 205, SLH 1963, which provides that applications for special permits be submitted to the county planning commissions or zoning board of appeals.

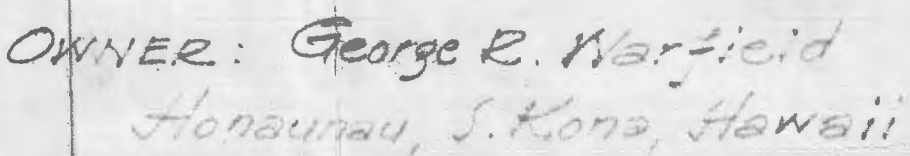
