To consider the reclassification of approximately 4.6 acres of land currently in the Conservation District to the Agricultural District at Wailea, South Hilo, Island of Hawai`i, to facilitate the consolidation and re-subdivision of three (3) existing legal lots of record and the contiguous former railroad right-of-way into three (3) lots in order to provide a more useful lot configuration.
