The United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit Court issued a memorandum (<a href="https://files.hawaii.gov/luc/docs/Memorandum.pdf">https://files.hawaii.gov/luc/docs/Memorandum.pdf</a>) on February 19, 2025, affirming the district court's ruling in favor of the State of Hawai'i Land Use Commission in the case brought by DW Aina Le'a Development, LLC.
