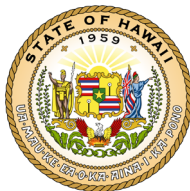

Oral Public Testimony. To provide oral public testimony, you can attend the Commission meeting in person at the physical meeting location or remotely via the Zoom link, as listed on page 1. Participants attending via Zoom who wish to provide oral testimony should use the Q&A feature during the scheduled meeting, stating the agenda item on which they wish to testify; testifiers will be unmuted and called upon when it is their turn to speak. Participants joining by telephone who wish to provide oral testimony should press *9 to raise their hand and will be unmuted when called upon. We strongly encourage participants to limit to two minutes for each testifier per agenda item.

Written Public Testimony. We encourage interested persons to submit written testimony in advance of the meeting, which will be distributed to Commission members prior to the meeting to allow for a timely review. To ensure the Commissioners have time to review your written testimony, we suggest that it reaches us at least 24 hours before the scheduled meeting. Late written testimony will be retained as part of the record and distributed to Commission members as soon as practicable, but we cannot ensure that the Commission will receive it in sufficient time to review, prior to decision-making.

Executive Session. During the scheduled meeting, the Commission may elect to go into Executive Session for reasons limited to those set forth in section in HRS § 92-5(a)(2), to consider the evaluation of an officer or employee where consideration of matters affecting privacy will be involved, and in section HRS § 92-5(a)(4), to consult with its legal counsel on questions and issues pertaining to the Commission's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities.
