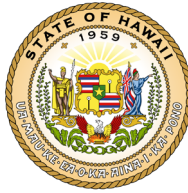

Public Testimony via Interactive Conference Technology (Zoom): To provide oral public testimony, you can attend the Commission meeting in person at the physical meeting location or remotely via the Zoom link, as listed on page 1.

Participants attending via Zoom who wish to provide oral testimony should use the Q&A feature only to indicate that they wish to testify and identify the agenda item. Testifiers will be unmuted and called upon when it is their turn to speak. The Q&A feature is not for submitting substantive comments to the Commission. Members of the public wishing to provide substantive comments should do so during their oral testimony or submit written testimony in accordance with the agenda instructions.

Public Testimony via Telephone: On the day of the meeting at the start of the agenda item you wish to testify on, participants joining by telephone should press *9 to raise their hand and will be unmuted when called upon. We strongly encourage participants to limit to two minutes for each testifier per agenda item.

Written Public Testimony. We encourage interested persons to submit written testimony in advance of the meeting, which will be distributed to Commission members prior to the meeting to allow for a timely review. To ensure the Commissioners have time to review your written testimony, we suggest that it reaches us at least 24 hours before the scheduled meeting. Late written testimony will be retained as part of the record and distributed to Commission members as soon as practicable, but we cannot ensure that the Commission will receive it in sufficient time to review, prior to decision-making.

Written testimonies may be posted to the LUC meeting website; as a precaution, please be mindful with any personal information prior to submitting it unless you intend for it to be shared.

Executive Session. During the scheduled meeting, the Commission may elect to go into Executive Session pursuant to HRS § 92-5(a)(4) to consult with its legal counsel on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities.
