Presentations

Mr. Derrickson presented the EIS process and reason for being the accepting authority and Ms. Segura presented the substance of the staff report and staff recommendations. The staff report was posted to the LUC website on November 14, 2025.

Petitioner's counsel, Mr. Ueoka, provided a brief background on their determination for an EIS and requested that the Commission serve as the accepting authority. The presentation included their conceptional layout site plan and vision for the project. They explained prior coordination with the Maui Planning Department and County Council, described the project's long-term phased buildout, affordable housing goals, infrastructure needs, environmental considerations, and anticipated impacts and mitigations, and noted their intention to return with a Final EIS. Commissioner's asked questions regarding schedule, consultants, and the overall project value.

Ms. DesJardins stated that the Planning Department has no opposition to the motion but urged the Commission to consider requiring a noise study either before acceptance or as a condition of acceptance due to community concerns. The petitioner responded that they had already hired a noise consultant and planned to incorporate into the Final EIS. Ms. Kato stated that OPSD has no objection to the motion.

Public Testimony

The LUC received one written testimony from Professor Richard Dick Mayer. During the first and second opportunity for public testimony, Professor Richard Dick Mayer provided additional testimony emphasizing the petitioner needs to do a noise study and work with the DOT Airports Division regarding placing housing units under a flight path.

Deliberations

The motion was made to accept the petitioners Motion to Designate the LUC as Accepting Authority and for Authority to Prepare an EISPN. The motion was moved by Commissioner Carr Smith and seconded by Commissioner Hayashida. The motion passed with 7 ayes and 2 absent.
