- 2 order. This is an action meeting on SP70-85 DeLUZ
- 3 TRUCKING & GRAVEL to consider granting an amendment to
- 4 Condition No. 2 to extend the special permit for five
- 5 years to December 11, 2015.
- 6 Will the parties identify themselves for the
- 7 record starting with the Applicant.
- 8 MR. HAITSUKA: Good morning. My name is Ed
- 9 Haitsuka. I'm the attorney for the Applicant Edwin
- 10 Deluz Trucking and Gravel, LLC. And with me today is
- 11 the Applicant's representative Mr. Kevin Balog.
- 12 CHAIRMAN DEVENS: Good morning.
- MR. BRILHANTE: Good morning. William
- 14 Brilhante, deputy corporation counsel, county of
- 15 Hawai'i along with Ms. Bobby Jean Leithead-Todd,
- 16 planning director, county of Hawai'i.
- 17 CHAIRMAN DEVENS: Good morning.
- 18 MR. YEE: Good morning. Deputy Attorney
- 19 General Bryan Yee on behalf of the Office of Planning.
- 20 With me is Mary Alice Evans from the Office of
- 21 Planning.
- 22 CHAIRMAN DEVENS: Good morning to you all. On
- 23 December 22, 2010 the Commission received the County
- 24 of Hawai'i's Department of Planning's Decision and
- 25 Findings of Applicant's Request To Amend Condition 2,

- 1 life of permit, of LUC Docket No. Alpha 70-85. We're
- 2 going to first take public testimony. Are there any
- 3 witnesses signed up, Dan?
- 4 MR. DAVIDSON: No witnesses.
- 5 CHAIRMAN DEVENS: We have the complete record
- 6 from the planning commission. The Commissioners have
- 7 had a chance to review the entire record. My
- 8 understanding is that the recommendation is that
- 9 Condition No. 2 be amended to extend the termination
- 10 date from December 11, 2010 to December 11, 2015. Is
- 11 that the understanding of the parties? Applicant?
- MR. HAITSUKA: It is, Mr. Chair.
- 13 CHAIRMAN DEVENS: County?
- MR. BRILHANTE: That's correct, Mr. Chair.
- 15 CHAIRMAN DEVENS: Office of Planning?
- 16 MR. YEE: Yes.
- 17 CHAIRMAN DEVENS: The other recommendation is
- 18 to add a Condition No. 3 which reads as follows:
- 19 Mining of Pu'u Hinai shall immediately cease to
- 20 protect and preserve the pu'u in compliance with the
- 21 South Kohala Community Development Plan.
- 22 And a Condition No. 5 that reads as follows:
- 23 The Applicant shall submit a soils report of the
- 24 minded area of Pu'u Hinai by an engineer qualified in
- 25 the field of soil mechanics and licensed within the

- 1 state of Hawai'i, that 90 days from the effective date
- 2 of this amendment.
- 3 The soil report shall provide recommendations
- 4 for the stabilization of Pu'u Hinai shall be submitted
- 5 to the planning director for review and approval in
- 6 consultation with the Department of Public Works.
- 7 The Applicant shall comply with the
- 8 recommendations of the approved soils report to
- 9 stabilize the pu'u in bringing it into a non-hazardous
- 10 condition.
- 11 Additionally, the Applicant shall comply with
- 12 any other measures determined by the planning director
- 13 to provide reasonable assurance with the stability of
- 14 Pu'u Hinai and the safety of people who may work in
- 15 reasonably close proximity to the pu'u.
- 16 Is that your understanding of the additional
- 17 conditions that are being recommended to us,
- 18 Applicant?
- MR. HAITSUKA: Yes, it is, Mr. Chair.
- 20 CHAIRMAN DEVENS: County?
- MR. BRILHANTE: Yes, Mr. Chair.
- 22 CHAIRMAN DEVENS: OP?
- MR. YEE: Yes.
- 24 CHAIRMAN DEVENS: Do any of the parties have
- 25 any objections to those recommendations? Applicant?

- 1 MR. HAITSUKA: We have no objections.
- 2 CHAIRMAN DEVENS: County?

- 9 request regarding Pu'u Hinai, what is the status of
- 10 public accessibility or non-accessibility?
- 11 MR. HAITSUKA: There's presently no public
- 12 accessibility to the area in question. It's on
- 13 private land. The access to the property is gated.
- 14 COMMISSIONER HELLER: Okay. Thank you.
- 15 CHAIRMAN DEVENS: Any further questions? At
- 16 this time I'd like to move that we approve the
- 17 Applicant's request for the five-year time extension
- 18 to the special use permit along with the
- 19 recommendations to add Conditions 3 and 5 as
- 20 recommended to us from the planning commission. Is
- 21 there a second?
- 22 COMMISSIONER KANUHA: Second.
- 23 CHAIRMAN DEVENS: Second by Commissioner
- 24 Kanuha. Is there any discussion? Hearing none, Dan,
- 25 if you can take the vote.
