Chairperson Hoe announced that there are several motions that are pending before the Commission to be disposed of.

The Commission received the Motion to Strike DLNR's Testimony filed March 15, 1996 by Intervenors (Coalition), the Motion to Dismiss filed March 15, 1996 by Intervenors (Coalition), the Joint Motion to Dismiss filed by Plan to Protect, the responsive pleading filed by Petitioner, Intervenors' (Coalition) reply to Petitioner's Response, and Petitioner's response to Intervenors' (Coalition) response.

Chairperson Hoe denied Intervenors' (Coalition) Motion to Strike DLNR's Testimony.

Arguments on the Motion to Dismiss were heard from Mr. Matsukawa and Mr. Tsukazaki. Chairperson Hoe denied Intervenors' (Coalition) Motion to Dismiss and Plan to Protect's Joint Motion to Dismiss.

The following motions were granted by Chairperson Hoe:

a. The Motion to Correct Transcript for the Hearing on November 17, 1995;

- b. The Motion to Correct Transcript for Hearing on March 27, 1996 filed by Petitioner;
 - c. The Motion for Oral Argument filed by Intervenors;
- d. Motion to Correct Transcript for hearing on March 27, 1996 filed by OSP.

Having no further arguments, the Motion to Strike County of Hawaii's Proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Decision and Order was denied by Chairperson Hoe.

The requests to withdraw the following motions were granted by Chairperson Hoe:

- a. Motion to Strike Witness lists filed by Intervenor (Plan to Protect) on March 27, 1996;
- b. Motion for Clarification of Order Granting Petitioner's Motion to Quash Subpoena Duces Tecum, Motion for In Camera Review of Master Lease, and Motion to Set Procedure Pending Plan to Protect Inc.'s Appeal to Third Circuit Court filed November 6, 1995 (Request for Withdrawal filed May 3, 1996);
- c. Motion to Bar Documentary Evidence filed December 1, 1995 (Request for Withdrawal filed May 9, 1996)

At this time Chairperson Hoe closed the proceedings and allowed the parties an opportunity for closing arguments.

Closing arguments were heard from Mr. Tsukazaki, Mr. Giannini, Mr. Archer, Mr. Powell, Mr. Matsukawa, Ms. David, Mr. Young, Ms. Eoff, Ms. Damate, and Ms. Springer.

It was determined by Chairperson Hoe that all of the Commissioners present were eligible to participate in the action on the Petition.

Commissioner Senda moved to approve the petition by Kaupulehu Developments subject to twenty-five conditions. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Kelai and polled as follows:

Ayes: Commissioners Senda, Kelai, Mattson, Wada, Chun, and Hoe

Nays: Commissioners Jarman and Kawakami

Commissioner Jarman stated for the record that the petition should be denied because the Petitioner has failed to meets its burden under the law in four key areas as follows:

- a. Native Hawaiian Rights
- b. Impacts on natural resources
- c. Environmental considerations
- d. Economic analysis
