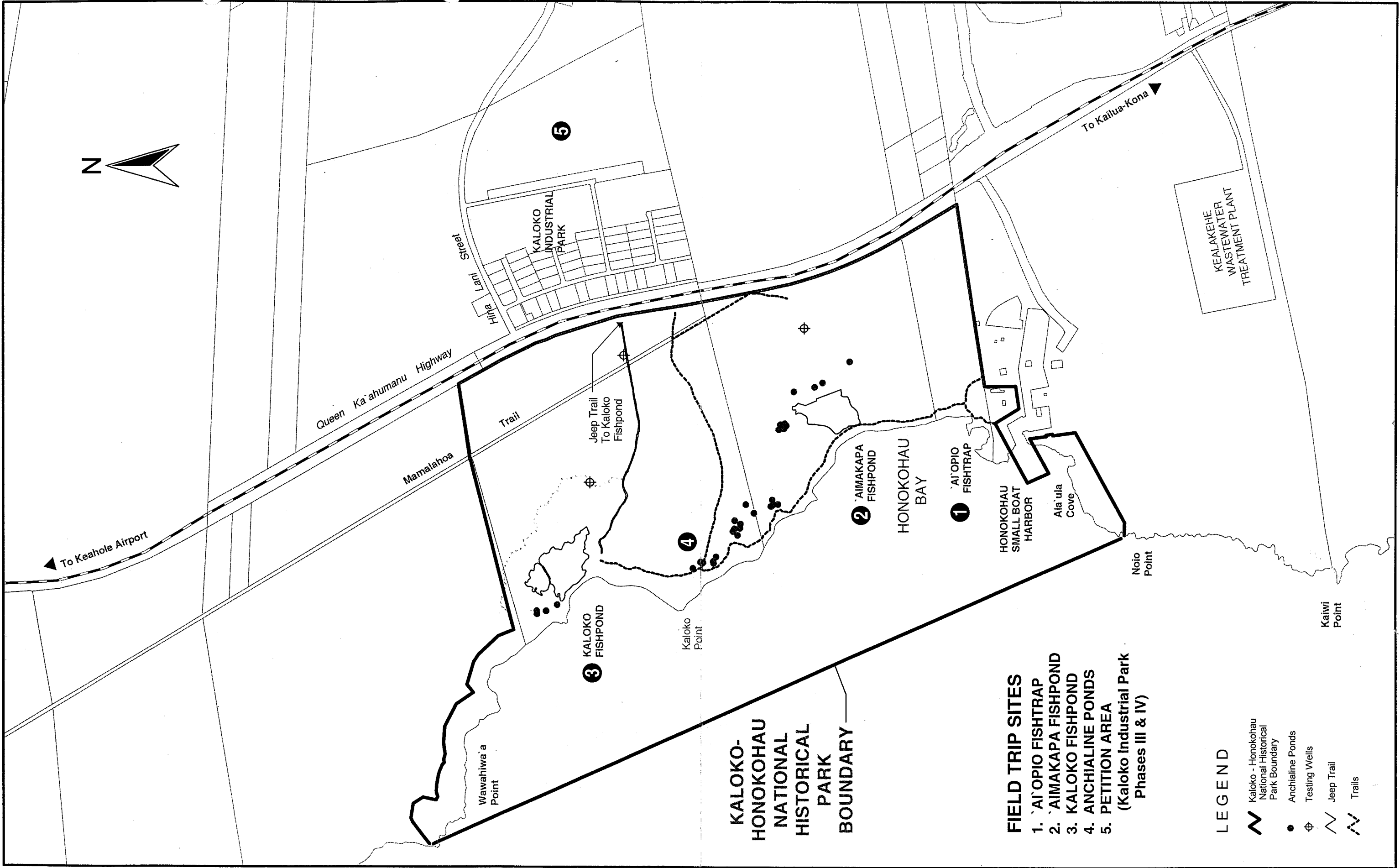

| 3:10-3:20 PM | Observation at Aiopio Fishtrap - natural and cultural resource features.  |
| 3:20-3:45 PM | Walk along the beach to Site 2: Aimakapa Fishpond, observe cultural and natural features along the coast and at the fishpond. |
| 3:45-4:05 PM | Walk back to the parking area through Aimakapa area and salt pan.   |
| 4:05-4:25PM  | Drive to Site 3: Kaloko Fishpond.   |
| 4:25-4:35PM  | Observation at Kaloko Fishpond - observe cultural and natural features.   |
| 4:35-4:50 PM | Walk to Site 4: anchialine pools, observe mauka landscape and cultural features.  |
| 4:50-5:00 PM | Walk back from anchialine pools.  |
| 5:00 PM      | Leave Kaloko Fishpond.  |
| 5:00-5:10 PM | Drive to Site 5: Petition Area.   |
| 5:10-5:30 PM | Observation at Petition Area - observe proposed project site and surrounding areas.   |
