**GOVERNOR GREEN SECURES IRS DEADLINE EXTENSION FOR  
STORM-AFFECTED RESIDENTS, BUSINESSES**

HONOLULU — Resulting from a request for disaster relief by Governor Josh Green, the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) has announced federal tax relief for individuals and businesses in Hawai'i affected by the severe storms, flooding and mudslides during the recent state-declared Kona-Low disaster that began on March 10, 2026.

Residents and owners of businesses in the federally declared Hawai'i severe storms disaster area, which includes the counties of Hawai'i, Honolulu, Kaua'i and Maui, now have until July 8, 2026, to file federal tax returns and make tax payments that were originally due on or after March 10, 2026.

"I am pleased and grateful that our request for a federal disaster declaration could also bring relief to Hawai'i taxpayers," said Governor Green. "I applaud the IRS for extending the federal tax deadlines and providing other relief for those impacted by this disaster."

The relief applies to individual income tax returns, certain business tax filings, quarterly payroll filings and certain excise tax payments.

The IRS will automatically identify and apply relief for taxpayers in the declared disaster area. Those located outside the covered area but affected by the disaster may request relief by contacting the IRS.
