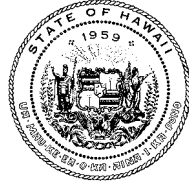

### REVENUE TRENDS – APRIL 2009

Tax revenues for the month of April 2009 totaled \$345.4 million. Ten months into the 2009 fiscal year, tax collections are down 7.8% compared to the same period in the previous fiscal year.

General excise and use tax (GET) collections totaled \$195.6 million in April. For the year-to-date FY 2009, GET collections decreased by 7.4 % compared to the same period in the previous year.

Transient accommodations tax (TAT) collections were \$16.8 million for the month. For the first ten months into FY 2009 TAT collections are down by 9.4% compared to the same period last year.

Individual income tax collections amounted to \$65.7 million for April. For the first ten months of FY2009 they are down by 5.1% compared to year-to-date last fiscal year.

Corporate income tax collections for the year-to-date FY 2009 were down by \$18.4 million.

Taxes allocated to Honolulu county surcharge collections for April 2009 totaled \$13.3 million.

### STATE GENERAL FUND

State general fund tax collections for the month of April 2009 totaled \$284.8 million. For the first ten months of fiscal year 2009, general fund deposits are down by 6.8% over the same period last year.
