Dear Governor Green:

In its meeting on October 30, 2025, the Council on Revenues (the "Council") lowered the Hawai'i Total Personal Income (TPI) forecast for calendar year (CY) 2025 to 4.5% and lowered the forecast for CY 2026 to 4.0%.

The Council noted that the revised TPI figures in September 2025 by the U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA) led to an increase in the growth rates in prior years compared with BEA's previously published data. The Council pointed to weakening visitor activity and labor market conditions in lowering its forecast.

The updated data for Hawaii's TPI for calendar years 2020 through 2024, along with the Council's current forecasts for 2025 and 2026, are shown below:
